Submission Procedure

Special session proposals should be sent to the Special Session Co-Chairs (Tiago.Falk@inrs.ca). The proposal should provide the following information: title, motivation and objectives, topics of interest, confirmed papers (title, authors, and abstract), contact information for the special session organizers, organizers' short biographies, and a list of potential reviewers capable of reviewing papers submitted to the special session. Proposals will be evaluated based on topic novelty and impact, organizing committee qualifications, and proposed list of contributed papers. Submissions to approved Special Sessions will undergo the same reviewing process as regular papers and are expected to meet the same quality standards.


